#5170 XTREME "FLAT FINISH"KLEAR is a matte finish clearcoat designed to offer that very popular Old School, no gloss look when used over any color basecoat paint, while offering the UV protection and durability of a standard clearcoat finish.

BASECOAT:

Compatible with most paint manufacturers' solvent and waterborne systems. Apply basecoat as per manufacturer's mixing and application instructions. Allow sufficient flash times before applying #5170. Inadequate flash time and uneven coats will affect the performance of the clear.

MIXING RATIO (6:1):

IMPORTANT: PICK UP FLATTENING AGENT FROM BOTTOM WITH STIR STICK, STIR VERY WELL, THEN AGITATE 45 MINS BEFORE POURING.

ALL NEW CUSTOMERS SHOULD SPRAY A TEST PANEL FIRST. APPROVE FINISH, BEFORE CLEARCOATING YOUR PROJECT.

- For temperatures ABOVE 60°F to 75°F (**OR SMALL PANELS**)
 Mix 6 parts #5170 FLAT FINISH Klearkote to 1 part #5182 Medium Activator
- For temperatures ABOVE 75°F (OR LARGE PANELS)
 Mix 6 parts #5170 FLAT FINISH Klearkote to 1 part #5184 Extra Slow Activator

APPLICATION:

Apply 2 **EVEN** wet coats with 75% overlap at 18-22psi at the inlet allowing a 10-15 minute flash between coats.

NOTE: SPRAY A TEST PANEL BEFORE CLEARCOATING YOUR PROJECT. Spraying slower using a 6 inch fan pattern and 6-8 inches from the panel will help keep a wet edge.

THINGS IMPORTANT to Do:

Shake (agitate) and STIR (stick) well before pouring.

Measure correct amount of Activator.

Observe flash times for proper flat finish.

Apply EVEN wet coats. Heavy wet coats will increase the gloss level.

Wash car by hand using plenty of water and a soft sponge.

THINGS NOT to Do:

NOT designed to go over bare metal.

Do NOT use if temperature is under 60°F/15°C.

Do NOT buff, sand, wax or polish surface, as the gloss level will increase.

DRY TIMES AT 77°F:

Flash Time 10-15 mins
DUST FREE 30 Minutes
TACK FREE 60 Minutes

TO DELIVER 16-24 Hours (Air dry)

FORCE DRYING:

BAKE TIME @ 140° F for 40 Minutes

Allow a one to two hour cool-down time before delivery after force drying.

RECOATING:

#5170 may be recoated after an overnight dry at 77° F, or upon 1 to 2 hour cool down after force drying at 140° F for 40 minutes.

POT LIFE:

Pot life will be 3 - 5 hours at 77° F.

CLEAN UP:

Clean equipment immediately after use with compliant gun wash solvent.
